Right to Life, Liberty & Happiness

Wisconsin Constitution Article 1, Text of Section 1:

All people are born equally free and independent, and have certain inherent rights; among these are life, liberty and the pursuit of happiness; to secure these rights, governments are instituted,...

Right of Conscience

Wisconsin Constitution Article 1, T Section 18:

The right of every person to worship Almighty God according to the dictates of conscience shall never be infringed; nor shall any person be compelled to attend, erect or support any place of worship, or to maintain any ministry, without consent; nor shall any control of, or interference with, the rights of conscience be permitted,

Wisconsin Constitution Article 1, Section 11:

The right of the people to be secure in their persons, houses, papers, and effects against unreasonable searches and seizures shall not be violated; and no warrant shall issue but upon probable cause, supported by oath or affirmation, and particularly describing the place to be searched and the persons or things to be seized.

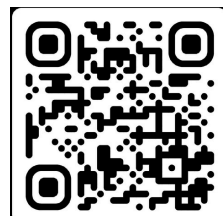

- to travel , etc.

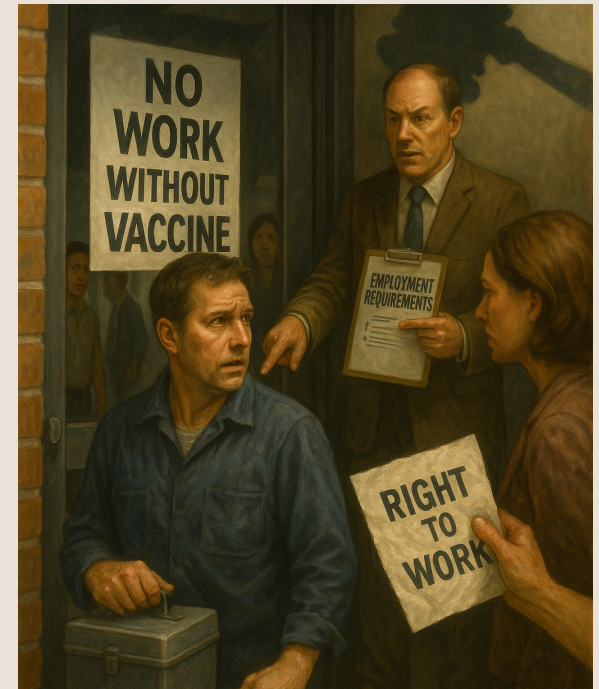
You have the right to your own Health care choices.

Please sign and serve all the people in your local government such as your school boards, your state legislators, county boards, sheriffs, state and federal senators, and the state and federal supreme courts.
